We are a non-profit organization that supports all Veterans programs and groups. We are a group of Combat tested Veterans whose motto is "Vets Helping Vets." We help our Veterans by fund raisers and donations provided by local businesses, like yours. The CVMA was formed for the betterment of communication and camaraderie between Veterans' Organizations. To promote interest in various forms of motorcycle activity associated with Veterans.

Some of the activities we are involved in include:

- Tomorrow's Hope Homeless Shelter for Veterans: We provided clothing, blankets, bedding, towels, etc. Throughout the year, we also have dinners with everyone at the homeless shelter.
- Visiting Veterans at the Van Zandt VA Hospital to provide blankets and gifts during the Holidays.
